

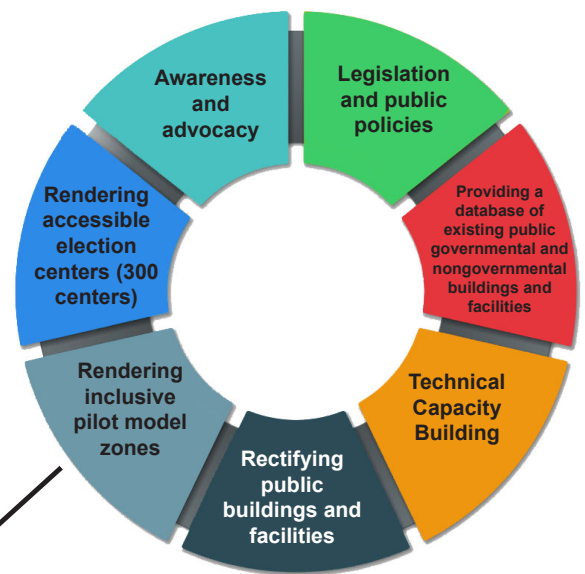
The “National Plan for Rectifying Existing Buildings and Public Facilities 2019-2029”

The “National Plan for Rectifying Existing Buildings and Public Facilities 2019-2029” comes in compliance with the provisions of the Law on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities No. 20 for the Year 2017, which obliges the relevant executive authorities, namely the Ministry of Public Works and Housing, the Greater Amman Municipality, Municipalities and others, as well as the Higher Council for the Rights of Persons with Disabilities; to develop a 10-year national plan that includes solutions and alternatives for existing public buildings and facilities, which in the course of 10 years will be made accessible for persons with disabilities and adapted to their requirements for access to services independently and on an equal basis with others.

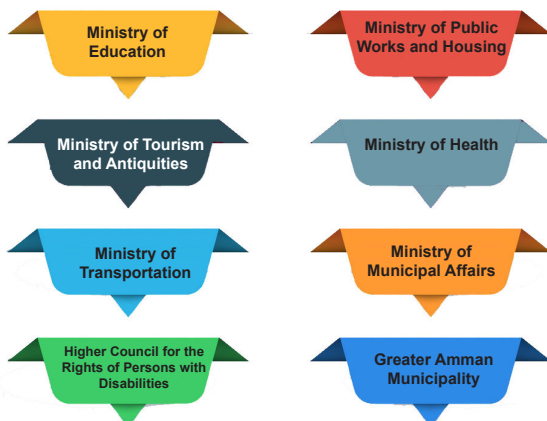
Overall Objective

To render accessible at least 60% of facilities and public buildings, which provide services to the public by 2029, by applying the provisions of the Building Code Requirements for People with Disabilities and / or finding appropriate alternatives as necessary.
